

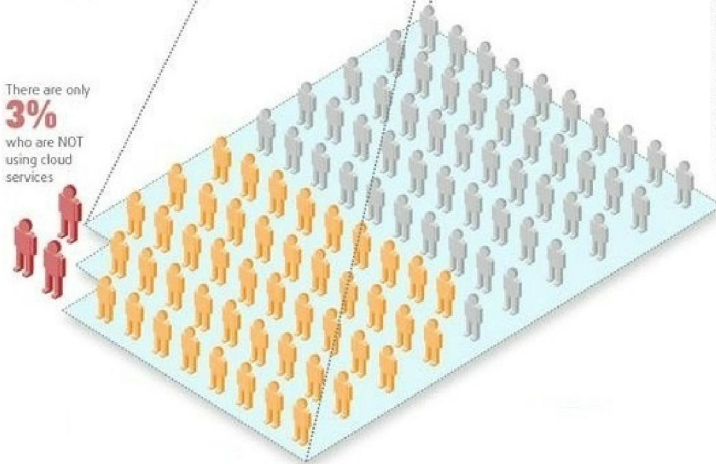
Everything as a Service

Because enterprises are adopting the cloud.

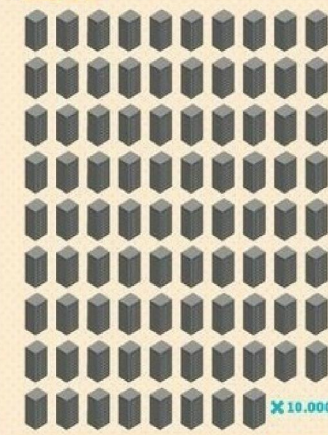
By 2016

And this is fueling server growth

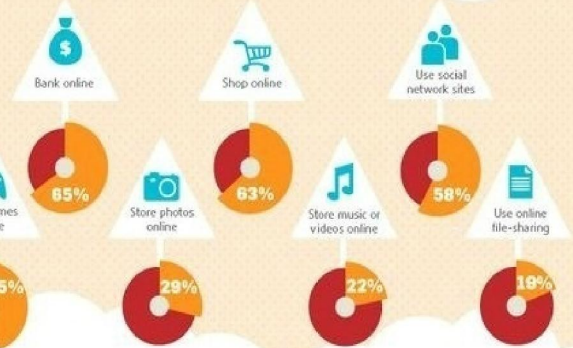
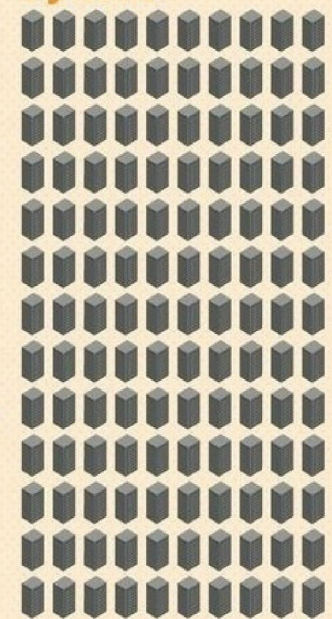

Whether people realize it or not, we have entered the era of **Everything as a Service**.

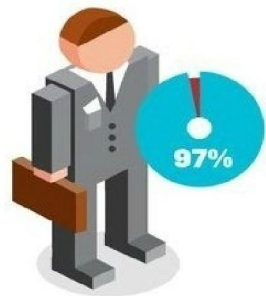
What is **Everything as a Service?**
